Dear colleagues,

it is our pleasure and privilege to invite you to visit the beautiful city of Brno at the borders joining the Czech Republic, Slovakia and Austria. We invite you to join this state of the art oncologic congress focused on lymphoproliferative and histiocytic disorders in small animal medicine. Please fix the date of 7.-8th October, 2016 on your calendar.

Our program starts on Friday 7th of October with cytologic preconference under the direct supervision of *Prof. Ilse Schwendenwein, DECVCP* and *Dr. Abigail Guija, DECVCP* focusing on the topic of **Cytology of round-cell tumors**, where you will learn how to take and interpretate **samples from the skin, lymph nodes and visceral organs**. You will also be informed on how to distinguish **round cell tumors from inflammatory disorders** based on cytology. You will practice the **morphology of lymph nodes** in lymphoma, reactive and metastatic processes and gain overview how to differentiate neoplastic populations of lymphocytes, plasma cells, mast cells and histiocytic cells from inflammatory population in **visceral organ samplings** and also in **peripheral blood**.

The main program will be held on Saturday, the 8th of October with a key topic of **Advance therapy in canine lymphoma** under supervision of *Dr. Laura Marconato, DECVIM-CA*, *Prof. Miriam Kleiter, DACVR-RO, DECVIM-CA* and *Dr. Kamil Tomsa, DECVIM-CA*.

Dr. Kamil Tomsa will speak about diagnostics and treatment of **infectious causes** which may be associated with lymphoma formation or could imitate lymphoma. *Dr. Tomsa* will also introduce you to the most frequent **paraneoplastic syndromes** connected to a lymphoma and show you a diagnostic and therapeutic approach to them.

Dr. Laura Marconato will be focusing on **practical decision making in therapy of lymphoma according to stage and WHO type**. You will find out which lymphoma patients only need **'wait and see'** strategy without any medical treatment. You will discover in which patients an **oral treatment** is suitable and which exact treatment could be used. You will learn to determine which dogs benefit from **combine protocols** and which **protocol** fits best in the particular situation. You will become a master how to deal with **lymphoma recurrence** after an initial chemotherapy and **progression** during the therapy. You will get experience in practical options of modern **remission control and personalized treatment** for each particular patient. Bear in mind there would be a commercial possibility of **canine lymphoma immunotherapy** available in the near future. *Dr. Marconato* will introduce you to the most important ones.

Prof. Miriam Kleiter is one of the founders of veterinary radiooncology in Europe. You will understand which **lymphoma** types could profit from the **radiotherapy** as a sole treatment or a part of combined oncologic therapy in the consolidation phase or even as a rescue treatment.

Congress attendees will have the chance to benefit from scientific exchange during either the formal activities or the informal meetings with colleagues from different backgrounds. Everyone will also have a chance to relax and enjoy themselves thanks to the many opportunities provided by a beautiful Capitol of Moravia.
