The majority of the diagnostic work originates from small animals, with a smaller but significant number of equine, large animals, avian and exotic specimens. Alongside the Reference Laboratories duties, the Clinical Pathology Team is regularly involved in supporting our IDEXX in-house customers with the interpretation of laboratory results generated by the IDEXX in-house instruments. Finally, customer education, participation in validation studies, and internal training of our technical staff complete the list of activities requested for this position.
