ECVCP resident position at the Department of Veterinary Clinical Sciences, Pathophysiology and Clinical Pathology, Justus-Liebig-University Giessen, Germany

The Department of of Veterinary Clinical Sciences, Pathophysiology and Clinical Pathology, Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Justus-Liebig-University, Giessen, Germany is accepting applications for a 3-year residency in veterinary clinical pathology.

The residency is designed to fulfil training requirements and eligibility for board certification by the European College of Veterinary Clinical Pathology (ECVCP).

Training will emphasize diagnostic cytology, haematology, and clinical chemistry and an annual external rotation.

The resident will participate in diagnostic service of the central laboratory, teaching of veterinary students, journal clubs, and seminars, and will be encouraged to attend and present at national/international meetings and write manuscripts for publication.

The Central Laboratory currently has one boarded clinical pathologist, one associate member ECVCP, one 1rst-year resident ECVCP (currently on maternity leave) and four post graduate students seeking the national specialisation in veterinary clinical pathology. Our diagnostic service is supported by a diverse case load (especially canine, feline and equine samples) with submissions from within the teaching hospital and from outside practices. Current research interests are in the field of haematology, automated haematology instruments, assessment of platelet activation, coagulation, and acute phase proteins.

Candidates for the position must have a DVM or equivalent degree. An internship or 2 years practice experience is mandatory as well as German language skills (oral and written). Applications should include curriculum vitae, statement of professional goals, veterinary school transcript, and a list of three references, and should be sent to Prof. Dr. Andreas Moritz, Frankfurterstr. 126, 35392 Giessen, Germany; Tel:++40641/9964138663.
