

2 Clinical Pathology Vacancies with CVS (Axiom and Finn) Laboratories (UK).

CVS is the largest veterinary group in the UK encompassing more than 350 veterinary surgeries, including three locations which are wholly referral practices. We operate four laboratories performing diagnostics services for the veterinary industry and seven pet crematoria. The Group also includes Animed Direct, an online store selling medicines, pet food and other animal related products.

The laboratories are located in Devon, Norfolk and Surrey and provide a wide range of diagnostic tests to both CVS and non-CVS practices; on average non-CVS cases make up 80% of the laboratories daily submissions. Our success is derived from the passion our people have for animals and for making pets a priority, it's what is at the heart of our work, every day.

Over the past couple of years the laboratories have seen a significant increase in our submission numbers and an even greater increase in the number of cytology cases so we are now looking for an additional Clinical Pathologists at both Axiom Laboratories, in Devon, and Finn Laboratories, in Norfolk. These roles are being created to help us cope with the current workload and allow for continued growth. You will be joining a team of 7 boarded clinical pathologists from a range of nationalities and backgrounds.

The main aspects of these roles will include: cytology, haematology, interpretation of laboratory results, phone consultations and input into the quality system and new processes and procedures. These roles will have a bias towards cytology and once established we expect you to be able to read and report on 30 cytologies in an 8 hour day; we will consider applicants looking for full or part time hours.

Applicants should preferably have, or be close to gaining, post graduate qualifications, and/or board certification in Clinical Pathology (ESVCP, ASCVP, FRCPath,) and be ready to work in a busy rewarding commercial environment. Applicants also need to be or be able to become members of the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons.

Salary is based on qualification, experience and cytology productivity up to £65,000 plus 25 days holiday, CPD, pension.
