The person appointed will be a key player in the provision of clinical pathology services to the Department of Veterinary Medicine, its associated clinics, ambulatory services and external clients. Participation in the practical instruction of veterinary students and the training of the Senior Clinical Training Scholars will form part of the position as will the management of the clinical pathology laboratory and its staff.
