- Investigate and implement initiatives for continuous process improvements
- Interaction with scientists and clients to communicate the significance of the clinical pathologic findings
- Maintain a consistent high level of productivity in the department as per industry standards
- Stay current in the science of toxicological clinical pathology, and remain informed on all legislation and developments related to the job through self-education and external training

- A Doctorate in Veterinary Medicine or equivalent, and a formal Residency training in Veterinary Clinical Pathology are required.
- Board certification by the American College of Veterinary Pathologists (ACVP) or European College of Veterinary Clinical Pathologists (ECVCP) is required
- Previous experience in toxicologic clinical pathology from a Contract Research Organization or pharmaceutical industry is required
- PhD is preferred but not required
- Supervisory/Managerial experience
- Strong knowledge of related legislation, principles, practices and procedures
- Oral and written English required. French is a definite asset
- Excellent oral and written communication and interpersonal skills
- Strong problem solving and analytical skills
- Demonstrated leadership ability
- Working knowledge of related computer applications
