San Marco Veterinary Laboratory offers a position for a resident in Clinical Pathology (ECVCP). San Marco is one of the most advanced veterinary laboratories in the world with a large caseload (more than 150,000 samples per year), accredited as an ECVPC training center for all disciplines: hematology, clinical chemistry, hemostasis, urinalysis, endocrinology and cytology. The facility also includes the San Marco Veterinary Clinic, a state-of-the-art tertiary hospital with a high case load in small animal medicine. The resident will rotate in the various departments of the lab in a stimulating, scientifically avant-garde and multidisciplinary environment, in close contact with boarded specialists from other disciplines (ECVIM, ECVD, ECVP).
