

Residency Position in Veterinary Clinical Pathology

A residency position in Veterinary Clinical Pathology located in the division of Clinical Pathology (Central laboratory) at the University of Veterinary Medicine in Vienna, Austria, is sponsored by Hoffmann-La Roche, Basel, Switzerland.

The residency programme follows the guidelines of the European College of Veterinary Clinical Pathology (ECVCP) at a training laboratory approved by the ECVCP.

An eligible candidate should fulfil the following requirements:

- Previous working experience in clinical settings such as one year of rotating internship or equivalent clinical training (minimum of 2 years).
- Basic experience and a strong interest in clinical pathology. Excellent language skills in German and English.
- Completed doctoral thesis is preferred.
- The candidate must consent to the current practice of preclinical safety studies in industry undertaken to develop safe products for humans and animals.

The candidate is invited to spend a maximum of 3 months/year in the Clinical Pathology unit at Hoffman-La Roche headquarters in Basel in clinical pathology as a sub-discipline of toxicology.
