



Temporary Lecturer in Veterinary Clinical Pathology (Maternity Cover) UE08

The Royal (Dick) School of Veterinary Studies wishes to appoint a full-time temporary lecturer in Veterinary Clinical Pathology. This one year position, beginning in January 2020, is an exciting opportunity to contribute to the further development of the School's teaching of clinical pathology, the diagnostic pathology service and the School's research programme.

Covering all aspects of clinical pathology, though mainly haematology and cytology, the successful candidate will play an important role in the diagnostic work of Easter Bush Pathology. There will also be opportunities to participate in the delivery and assessment of the BVM&S undergraduate teaching programme, to assist with eLearning and on-line teaching initiatives, and to contribute to the training of our current clinical pathology residents. As this is a short term position, the emphasis is primarily on diagnostic pathology and teaching as opposed to research. However, there will still be scope and expectation to participate in research within the School and the wider Centre for Comparative Pathology, where appropriate.

You will be based in Easter Bush Pathology, which is within the new Veterinary School building, opened in 2011. Interaction with colleagues across the range of disciplines will offer you support and incentive to further develop your interests and career ambitions.

You will hold a veterinary degree and will be an MRCVS (or eligible to become an MRCVS). You will be qualified in veterinary clinical pathology to diploma level (e.g. DipECVCP, DipACVP (Clin Path) or FRCPath), although Board-eligible candidates are also strongly encouraged to apply. Practical experience in the delivery of a diagnostic clinical pathology service is essential.
